April 14, 2009

Meeting was called to order by President, Brenda Snyder. The minutes of previous meeting were read and approved. Treasurer's Report given and one check to The Woodlands Country Club was written for \$382.59 for Entrance lighting at Valhalla Drive at Sparkleberry Lane. This amount covered the cost from 10-07 to 12-09. The lighting is \$14.27 per month. We now have 119 members.

Keith Anthony with Richland County Public Works Department was unable to present his program due to illness. Jim Breznay presented a brief overview of the Storm Water Outreach Program. Brochures were shared with the membership containing information of things that can be done by each resident to protect our storm drains; therefore, keeping our drinking water safe.

Hospitality Committee reported that the Directories should be ready by June. Announced that anyone interested in purchasing an ad should contact Judy. A report from the Landscaping/Beautification Committee relating to the Vahalla/Target entrance was presented by Scott Laughead. He informed the membership that the Executive Committee had approved a contractor, Carolina Ceramics, to construct a brick entrance like the Norse Drive entrance. As soon as permits are acquired, the construction will begin. The cleanup of entrances of Sparkleberry has begun and work should be completed by April 30. Scott also gave an update on petition for speed control on Valhalla. He is making initial contact and the block captains will make a second contact of those not home.

An announcement and sign up sheet for a July 4 activity for the neighborhood sponsored by the HOA was made and will be discussed at the June 16 meeting. The Clean Sweep was a success and thanks given to all who furnished food and drink for the County workers. All were encouraged to review Senate Bill 30 and contact the Senators because this bill directly affects our Association.

A special thanks to Laura, our webmaster, for the fantastic job that she has done with our website. She will be moving to California in May and we wish for her a safe journey.
